Most clubs at Ratton do not require students to sign up or have any costs. Students should speak to the staff member in charge of the club for more details.

It is the student's responsibility to discuss their attendance at clubs with parents to ensure their whereabouts are known.

In the unlikely event that a club has to be cancelled, we will aim to ensure that students receive advance notice of this. If a club has to be cancelled at short notice, for example due to staff illness on the day, we will always offer the supportive measures outlined below:

- Students should go to Reception (or Year Group office) to contact home. If it is a PE activity, they can also go to the PE office to use the phone.**
- Students are always welcome to attend another club on that day or go to Homework Club**

On no account should any student wait outside school on their own for long periods of time to be picked up, especially in the dark winter evenings. They are always welcome to wait in school.
