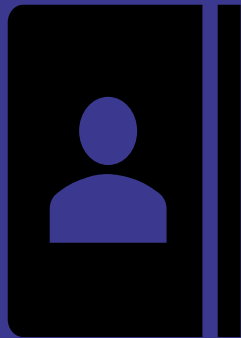
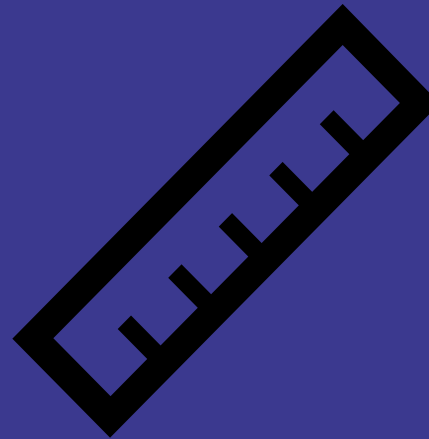
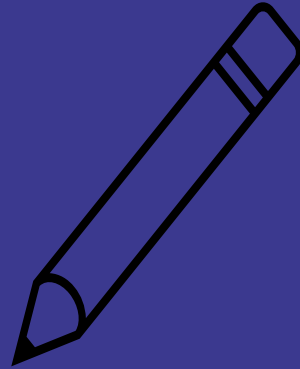
Ratton Uniform Policy

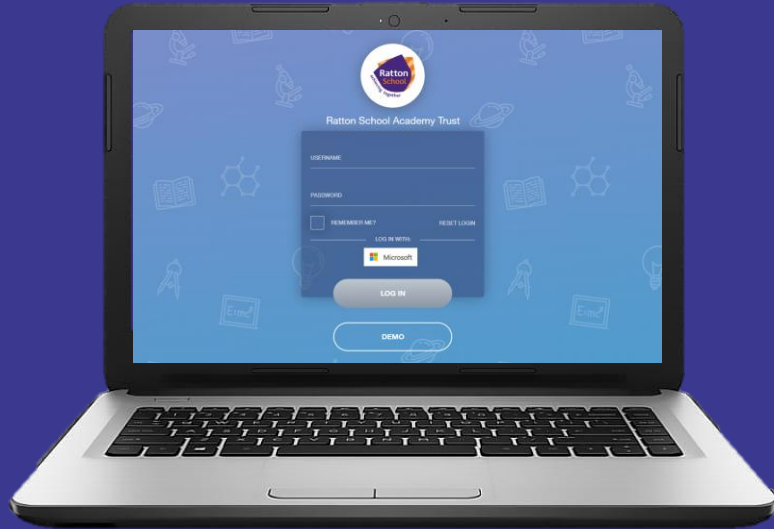

FAQ

Q . Can students come in early in the morning?

A. Yes, students can come in early in the morning from 8:15AM to attend a free Breakfast Club. No booking required.

Q.Can my child get a locker?

A. Yes, lockers are available through Parent Pay. However, due to the now limited number available, students will need to share with a friend or someone in their tutor group. Once an allocation has been decided, students are to collect a key from the main reception or, general office.

Q.What happens if my child is unwell at school?

A. To cater to all of our students, we have developed a 'Medical Oncall' process/system which is overseen by our Medical Officer and followed by all staff members. If your child is unwell, then an 'on-call' will be made where our Medical Officer will access your child accordingly. Should there be a need to send your child home then our Medical Officer (or Receptionist on their behalf) will make a call home to confirm and arrange collection and/or permission to walk home.



FAQ

Q.What's the school policy regarding mobile phones?

A. We have a no mobile phone policy in school. However, we appreciate that students may have these in their possession for use before or after school. Mobile phones should be switched off and in bags for the entirety of the school day.

Please note that the school will take NO RESPONSIBILITY for any damage caused to mobile phones or smart watches whilst at school.

Q.What's the school policy regarding piercings/hair/make-up?

A. Students should wear natural make up only, including no false nails or eye lash extensions. Nails should be painted in clear/natural colour only. Students are allowed to wear one pair of plain studs, (*no hoops*), which have to be removed for PE.
