

Financial support school trips abroad

At Ratton School we believe that all children who are identified as Pupil Premium (Children who have received Free School Meals in the last 6 years) should have a chance to experience a trip abroad in their time at the school. Therefore, the school, from the Pupil Premium budget will pay 25% towards one trip abroad during their time at Ratton School.

Students are welcome to attend more than one term time trip abroad between Year 7 - 11, however the 25% contribution will only be put towards their first trip abroad, full price will be charged for any subsequent trips.

The trips that are currently planned and qualify for this support for 2025/6 are:

- Paris Trip (Enrichment week)
- Madrid Trip (Enrichment week)
- Berlin Trip (October)

The school will also contribute 40% to the annual Year 8 camp.

The Pupil Premium budget is paid to the school to ensure we focus on the academic success of students. Therefore, we will also allocate funding to one-to-one tutoring, intervention activities in all years, helping students to attend school and raising aspirations/wellbeing sessions/careers workshops.
